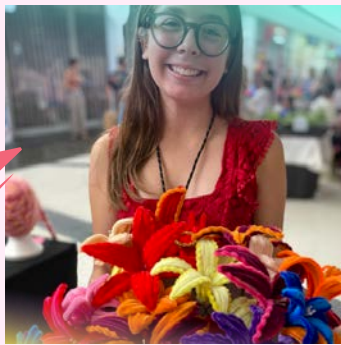

An Evening at the Museum

After the successful 'An Evening at the Museum' event last year, another one is being organised for Saturday 23 May, 4 pm at the Rambler Room, 60 Gordon St, Gordonvale (just across the railway line). Yvonne Gordon and Katina Davis will present the story of their well-known and community-minded parents – 'The Life and Times of Doc and Gill Davis: from dreary London to tropical Gordonvale.'

Mention the town of Herberton, and tin mining and boarding schools spring to mind. A lot of us would know of someone who attended one of the boarding schools. Dr Sarah Collins will share her great aunt's story as a boarder in her presentation, 'Nuns, an eclipse, and letters from home': Cicely Fulford's schooldays at St Mary's Church of England Girls' High School, Herberton in 1922' is the title of Sarah's talk.

Gordonvale Sugar Solstice and Country Fair



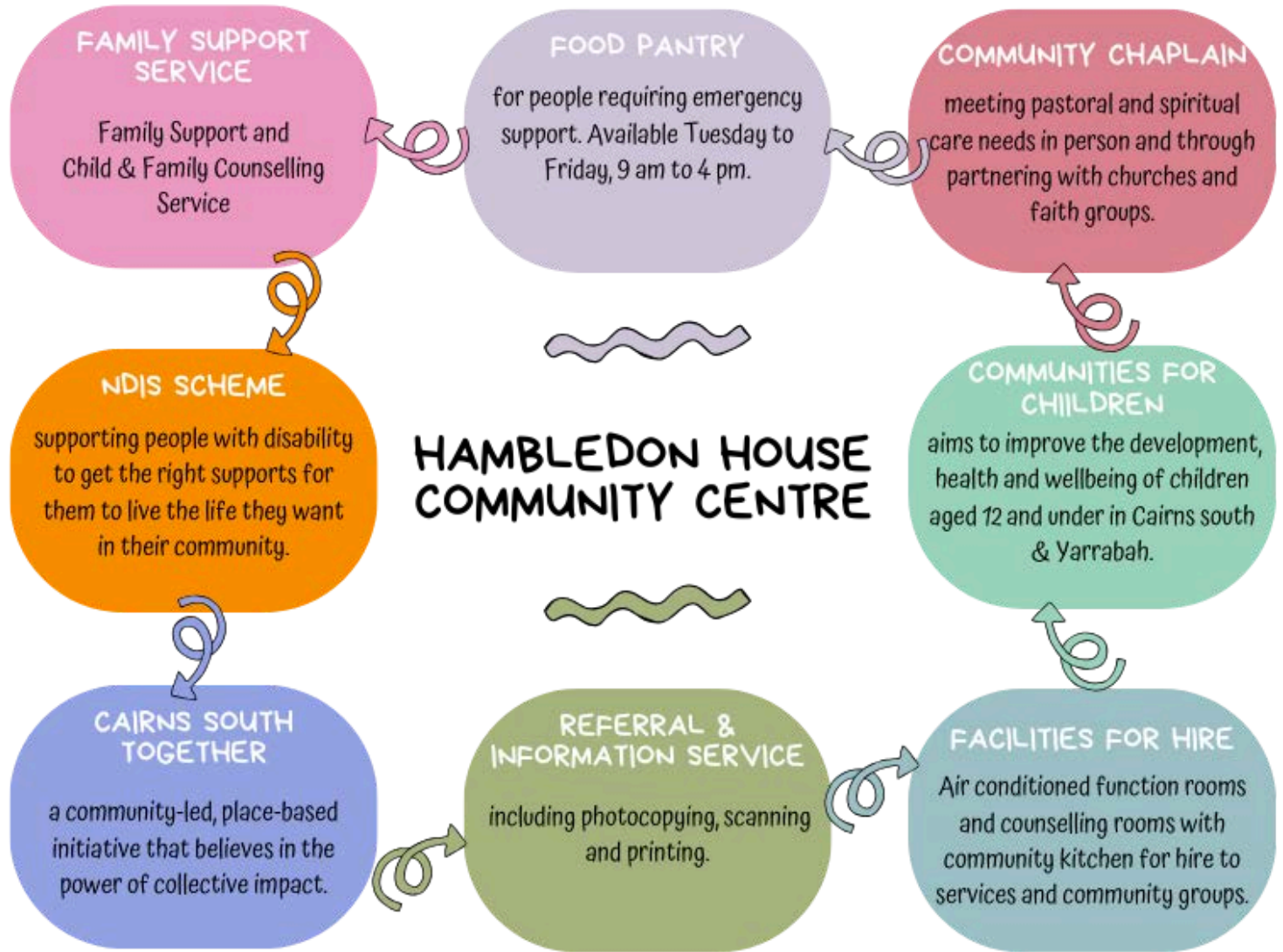
