Magic happens through partnership and collaboration. Last month, at St Mary's Catholic College's First Nations Leadership and Planning Day, the Cairns South Together backbone staff member, Andrew, together with Jess, the Child & Family Counsellor located at Hambleton House Community Centre, delivered a workshop addressing the critical importance of mental wellbeing for young people.

The aim of the workshop was to equip 40 youth with essential skills to recognise signs of distress, pathways and access to helpful resources, and the value and ways to practice self-care and be of mutual support for each other. Participants gained practical tools for navigating wellbeing while developing their literacy regarding mental health.

A highlight was the creative "mini heart workshop," where each student coloured a heart representing their personal journey. This activity was developed to connect the session with St Mary's ongoing painting of a large heart sculpture with Cairns South Together. The individual hearts symbolise both personal and collective community identity, mirroring the larger sculpture that will stand as a permanent reminder of connection and unity.

Feedback from the organiser, Tamara Pearson, was extremely positive, "...Your session on wellbeing and the importance of strong mental health and recognising when others are in need really resonated with our students and staff. Your own testimony regarding your life was truly inspirational. The Heart Project brought so much energy into the room-the kids were fully engaged, opened up, and came out of their shell in such a beautiful way. It was powerful to witness the positive impact you both had on them."

This collaboration marks a continued drive for community organisations and educational institutions to partner, ensuring young people receive consistent, culturally appropriate support that extends beyond the classroom, building resilience and a sense of community from the ground up.

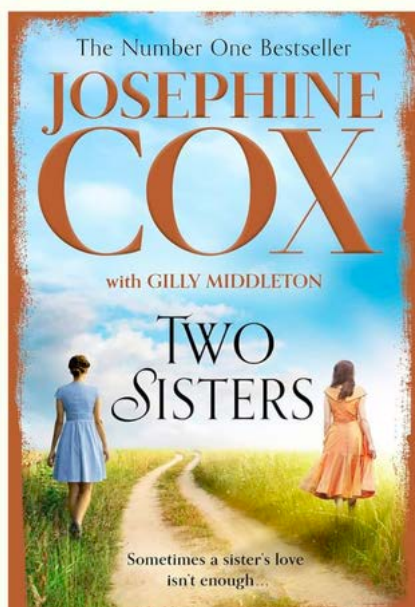

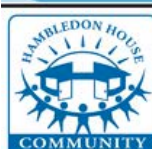

The Mulgrave History Museum, which is located at 60 Gordon Street Gordonvale, has a new display. Gordonvale Guides is celebrating 100 years, and we have a special exhibition featuring uniforms through the ages, photographs, badges, memorabilia and crafts. This exhibition will be on show until June of this year. Our opening hours are 10:00am to 2:00pm.

The Mulgrave Shire Historical Society is once again presenting Ghosts of Gordonvale at Gordonvale Cemetery on Sunday 23rd August 2026 at 3:00pm. The presentation will occur on the banks of O'Leary's Creek behind the monumental section of Gordonvale Cemetery. Attendees are asked to provide their own seating and water if needed. The stories being told are of six people buried in Gordonvale cemetery. They are Edith O'Neill, Carl Roos, Ferdinando Amadio, George Taylor, Richard Johnson, and Jane Roberts. The society hopes that any descendants of the ghosts being portrayed will be able to attend.

The information presented is historical and there is no presumption of ghostly presence.

Our presenters will be Mulgrave Shire Historical Society members dressed as their character. Come and enjoy a pleasant afternoon learning more about our local history told through the lives of our early pioneers.

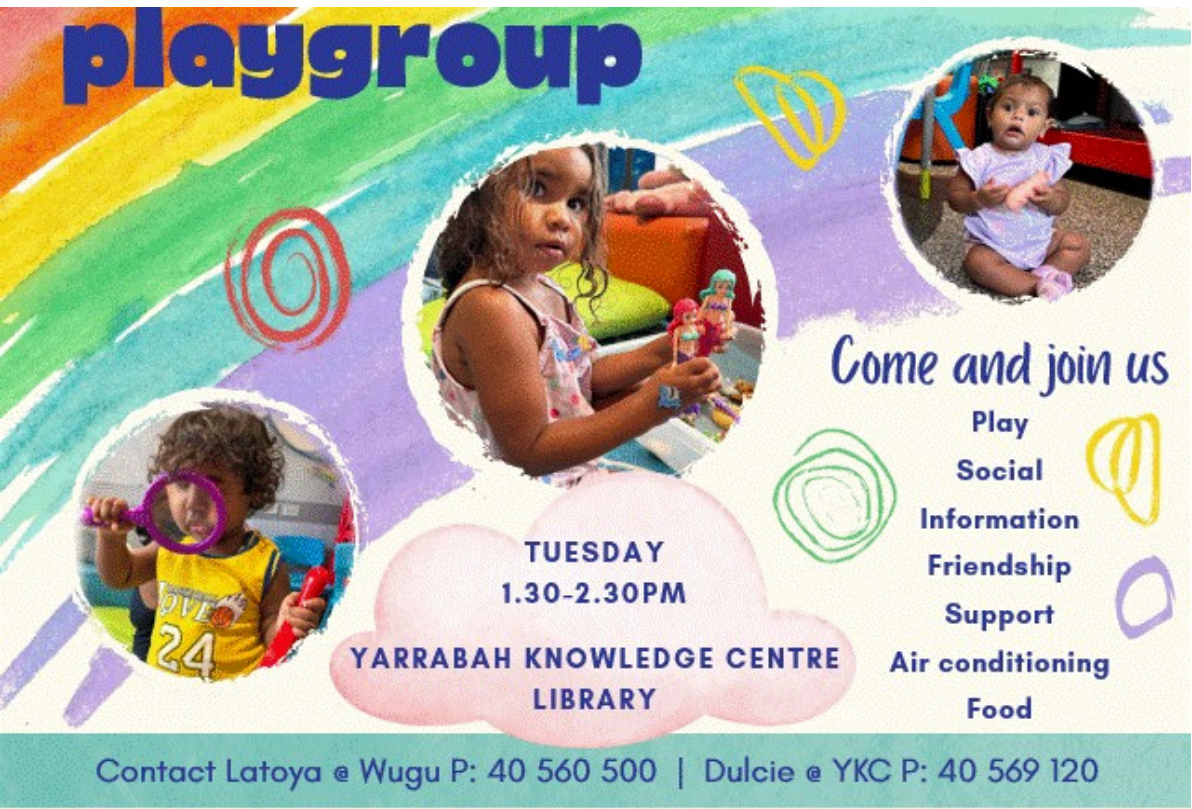

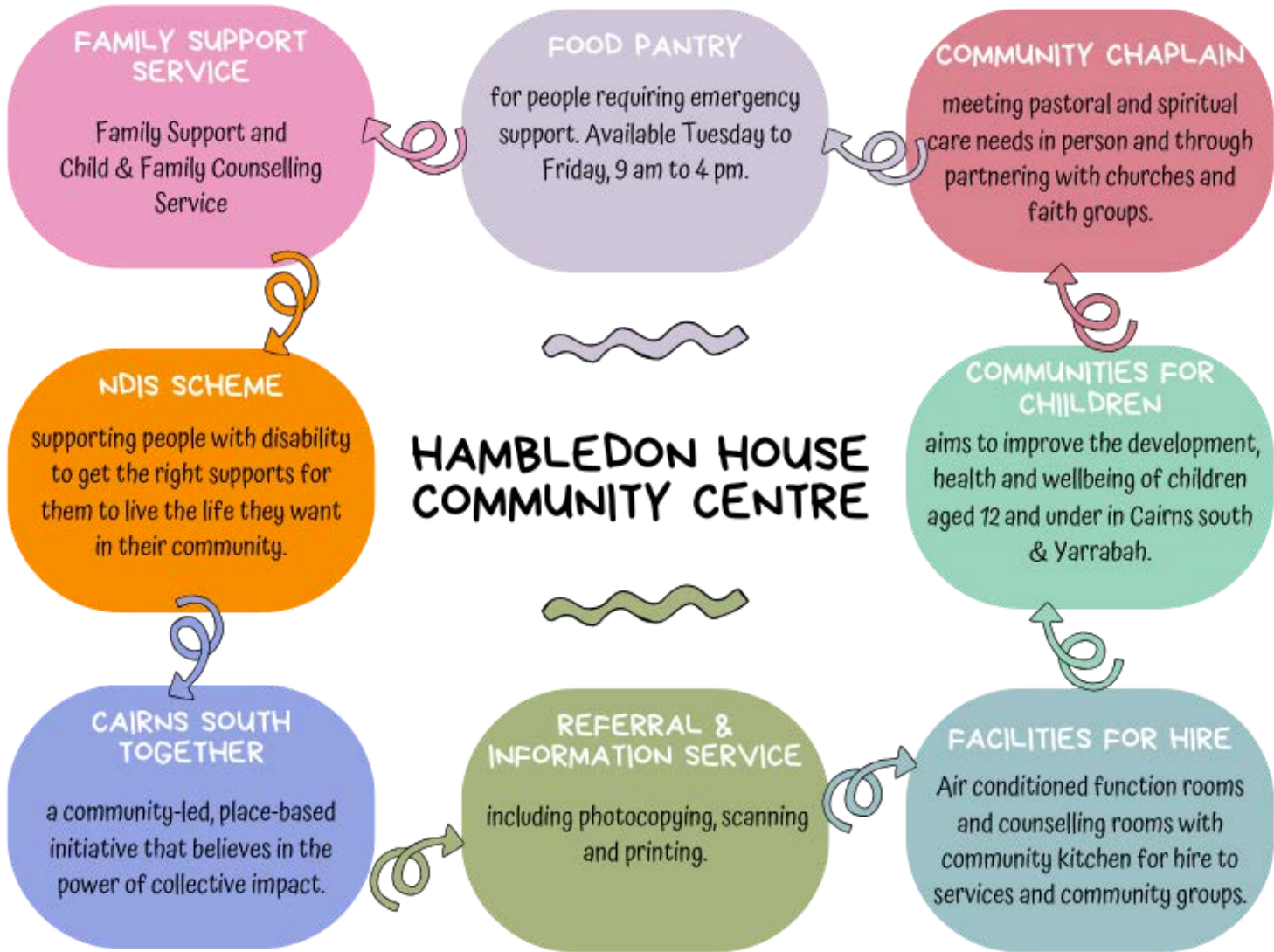

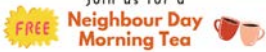
